

Project: Developing a long-term site plan and land acquisition of a 17-acre parcel located at 406 E. Young Street. The site plan includes Town Hall, Police Headquarters, Community Center, Fire Station, Veteran's Memorial, Wake County Library, and open space.

Update: Construction is underway and scheduled for completion by October 2023, with a move-in date of November 2023.





Rogers Rd/Willoughby Road Intersection

Project: Constructing an approved second entrance for the Willoughby subdivision using developer fee-in-lieu and Town funds.

Update: The project was put out for bid in late August with a Fall construction deadline. Bids far exceeded (more than doubled) the Engineer's estimate. Upon further review, the lowest bid had a calculation error. The firm ultimately withdrew their proposal. Our Town Engineer believes the (1) accelerated build schedule of this fall season, (2) Contractor questions about cut-fill, and (3) inflation within the construction market contributed to the higher-than-expected bids. The Town will rebid the project in October 2023 with (1) Spring 2024 build date and (2) updating Construction documents that include cross-sections.

Project: Constructing a multi-million street improvement project that incorporates a design based upon the Main Street Vision Plan for Main Street and Burlington Mills Road.

Update: Construction on the project's south end is moving as planned—utilities, water services, stormwater, etc. The Town is working with Fred Smith Company (FSC), Raleigh Water, and RK&K (the construction administration firm) to streamline the review process of in-field changes to the project plans. The foundation and stormwater infrastructure for the new segment and alignment of Burlington Mills Road is complete. Activity on the northern part of the project will begin soon; more specifically, grading the new parking lot at Young and Main. The communications team updated the project website with the most current information and photos.





Granite Acres Greenway

Update: A location has been identified and presented to PARAB at their July 2023 meeting. Staff has continued to work to plan to develop the site per the program outlined in the Appendix of the Greenway Master Plan. Due to long lead time, granite marker has been reserved for installation April/May 2024.





Mill Bridge Nature Park Amphitheater Renovation

Update: Design work is continuing with Town Engineer (Bolton and Menk) and a concept plan has been chosen. A cost estimate has been prepared. All design work will be completed by Spring/Summer of 2024.



Update: The Affordable Housing Advisory Committee has chosen a firm, TPMA, Inc., based in Indianapolis, IN, to assist the Town in drafting an Affordable Housing Plan. The Committee and consultant hosted a kick-off meeting on October 9 to get the project underway. The planning effort will start in earnest in early 2024 with community input and involvement. The committee agreed to meet bi-weekly starting in early November.
