



2015 Town of Rolesville Curbside Yard Waste Rules and Regulations

The Town of Rolesville contracts out the collection of all yard waste to a private contractor. Listed below are the rules and regulations regarding this service.

What is collected? Vegetative matter resulting from landscaping maintenance including but not limited to leaves, twigs, grass, limbs, hedge clippings, hay pine straw, pine cones, and logs.

What is NOT collected? Building materials, landscape materials, plant pots, plastic trays, mulch bags, dirt, rocks, no plants inside of pots, etc.

How should it be placed by the road? All debris should be placed into CLEAR plastic bags or 35 gallon trash containers. Limbs and brush larger than 1" but smaller than 6" in diameter must be no longer than 6'. Limbs and logs larger than 6" in diameter must not exceed 2'. Logs must not exceed 10" in diameter. No stumps, fences, poles, etc. will be collected by the Town. All items are to be placed at the curb by 7:00 AM on the day of pickup. Pickups will be from occupied residences only. Not from vacant lots or unoccupied properties.

- Place all brush in a single location by 7:00 am on day of pickup.
- Have it clean of trash.
- Have contractor remove his/her own waste.
- Have it separate from trash pickup.
- Use clear bags or marked containers
- Place at curb of residence.

How much will the town collect? Piles are not to exceed 4 cubic yards per bi-weekly pickup. Trash cans and bags are not to exceed 10 per bi-weekly pickup and not exceed 50 lbs. Logs are not to exceed 75 lbs per bi-weekly pickup. Yard waste must be free of trash, bricks, rocks, and other refuse.

What if a contractor is hired? Any yard waste pruned or cut by a contractor will be the responsibility of the contractor to remove from the property.

What about leaves? Leaves are picked up loose at the curb from October 12th through March 2nd of each year. From March 16th through September 28th of each year grass clippings, loose leaves, pine straw, etc. must be either placed in clear bags or in a container. Leaf piles and bags must be free of limbs, trash and debris.

2015 Yard Waste Pick Up Dates

2015 Town of Rolesville Residential Trash and Recycling Curbside Collection Rules and Regulations

The Town of Rolesville contracts with Waste Industries to collect all solid waste and recyclables. Below is a list of the rules and regulations regarding this service.

All trash and recycling are collected curbside on WEDNESDAYS across the entire town

TRASH

1. Place your container within 5 feet of the curb or edge of your street the night before your scheduled day of service. Our trucks start their collections at different times depending on the area that they are working.
2. Bag your household trash – please. This will help keep down the smell in your container and the possibility of loose trash blowing out of our trucks while in the process of dumping your container.
3. Extra trash – Your 96 gallon rollout cart is normally large enough to hold the trash that is produced by an average size family. An extra bag or two, occasionally, is permissible. Should there be an abnormally large amount of trash in the street we will either collect it or you will be charged an extra fee to have it collected. If it becomes common-place for this to happen, you will be asked to increase your level of service (number of carts) that will hold the volume of trash you are producing. The extra cart fee is \$8.70 per container per month.

RECYCLING

All of your recyclables will be picked up by one truck. Please combine paper, plastic, aluminum, and glass in ONE container and do not separate the materials. It is easier to separate them at the transfer site than at your residence.

Below are the items that ARE ACCEPTED at curbside:

Plastic

- Plastic items are recyclable if there are numbers 1-5 on the container (found on the base)
- Please be sure containers are EMPTY as much as possible
- Six pack holder rings

Glass

- Any color glass is acceptable except blue

Paper Products

- All white /colored paper with any color ink
- Computer paper, blueprints, phone books
- Copy paper, any color
- Sticky Notes, Index cards
- Envelopes (if it has a clear window, the clear material must be removed)
- FAX paper
- Cereal box type paper
- Milk cartons
- Notebook paper, personal stationary, posters
- Pamphlets and brochures (OK if glossy)
- Paperback books, magazines with glue or stapled binding
- Construction paper, brown craft paper or envelopes

- Newspaper & newspaper insert ads
- Phone Books
- Paper plates, paper towels, napkins which are TOTALLY clean
- Corrugated cardboard
- Aseptic juice boxes

Metal

- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum foil (no food residue)
- Metal food cans

Some of the items **NOT ACCEPTED** are the following:

- facial tissues
- photographs and photography paper
- copy paper wrappings from reams or any paper coated with a waxy material
- paper clips
- staples
- electronics
- yogurt cups
- margarine containers
- frozen food trays
- plastic wrap
- plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Stamps

RESTRICTIONS

1. Waste Industries does accept household waste that is in the 96 – gallon cart provided to you, 4 – 5 cardboard boxes, broken down and placed next to your container.
2. Waste Industries does not accept car tires, car batteries, construction debris, yard waste (grass, leaves, tree branches, mulch, dirt, etc.), flammable liquids, liquid paint, antifreeze, motor oil, other oils of any kind, or material classified as hazardous waste.
