Reference: Shooting at 104 N. Main Street

On Sunday, May 1, 2016 at approximately 0444 hours, Officers from the Rolesville Police Department were dispatched to 104 North Main Street concerning a subject that had been shot. Upon arrival, officers learned that James Michael Aaron was inside the residence and was on the phone with the Raleigh Emergency Communications Center. James Michael Aaron informed Raleigh Emergency Communications Center that he had shot an intruder, later identified as Wesley Collin Carpenter.

Officers entered the home to locate and assist the victim, Wesley Collin Carpenter. Wesley Collin Carpenter was transported to Wake Medical Center located at 3000 New Bern Avenue in Raleigh where lifesaving efforts were administered. It was determined that Wesley Collin Carpenter suffered multiple gunshot wounds. Wesley Collin Carpenter succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced dead.

Further investigation revealed that Wesley Collin Carpenter, Sophia Media Carpenter, and James Michael Aaron were all at Wesley Collin Carpenter's residence located at 1218 Colonial Club Road Wake Forest prior to the shooting.

Based on items of evidentiary value recovered through the execution of the search warrants, interviews, and the investigative process, it has been determined that Wesley Collin Carpenter was known by James Michael Aaron. There is no evidence of forced entry into the residence. This case remains under investigation.
