



2017 Town of Rolesville Yard Waste Rules and Regulations

The Town of Rolesville contracts out the collection of all yard waste to a private contractor. Listed below are the rules and regulations regarding this service.

WHAT IS NOT COLLECTED?

Building materials, landscape materials, animal waste, fencing pickets or poles, treated wood, plastic plant pots and containers, plastic trays, mulch bags, dirt, and the like. All yard waste **MUST** be free of trash, bricks, rocks, and other refuse as well. Due to access of equipment, the timeliness of collection, and safety, no stumps or large root balls will be collected or accepted.

WHAT IS COLLECTED?

Vegetative matter resulting from landscaping maintenance including but not limited to leaves, twigs, grass, limbs, hedge clippings, hay straw, pine straw, pine cones, and logs.

HOW TO GET YARD WASTE COLLECTED?

- All debris must be placed out by curbside no later than 7:00 am the Monday of collection
- As of July 1, 2017, clear bags are no longer accepted. This rule change results from repetitive problems with citizens placing inert debris and animal waste within the bags.
- All yard waste must be placed within five (5) thirty five (35) gallon size trash containers. No more than five (5) containers will be collected per residence. Each container cannot weigh more than 50 pounds.
- Limbs and branches can be placed within trash containers or loose by curbside. Any limbs placed loose must meet the following rules:
 - All limbs must face a similar direction. The purpose of this is safety and timeliness of collection.
 - All limbs with a diameter smaller than six (6) inches must not have a length greater than six (6) feet.
 - All limbs with a diameter greater than six (6) inches must not have a length greater than two (2) feet.
 - Logs must not have a length great than one (1) foot.
 - Piles of limbs must not exceed six (6) feet in height, ten (10) feet in length, and six (6) feet in depth.
- Grass clippings, loose leaves, pine straw, etc. must be placed within the containers between March 14, 2017 and September 11, 2017. From September 12, 2017 through next spring, such material can be placed loose by the curb.

WHEN WILL IT BE COLLECTED?

Below are the remaining yard waste collect dates till the end of calendar 2017.

- June 19
- July 3, 17, and 31
- August 14 and 28
- September 11 and 25
- October 9 and 23
- November 6 and 20
- December 4 and 18
