



2017 Political Sign Information

• Rolesville •

- Political signs may be posted in NCDOT right-of-ways as allowed by N.C.G.S. 136-32
- During the period, beginning on the 30th day before the beginning date of “one-stop” early voting under G.S. 163-227.2 and ending on the 10th day after the primary election day. This is **September 19th – November 17th**.
- Candidate must obtain permission of any property owner of a residence, business, or religious institution fronting the right-of-way where a sign is to be erected.
- No sign shall be placed in the right-of-way of a fully controlled access highway.
- No sign shall be closer than three feet from the edge of the pavement of the road.
- No sign shall obscure motorist visibility at an intersection.
- No sign shall be higher than 42 inches above the edge of the pavement of the road.
- No sign shall be larger than 864 square inches.
- It is a Class 3 misdemeanor for a person to steal, deface, vandalize, or unlawfully remove a political sign that is lawfully placed.
