Call to Order

Mayor Frank Eagles called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance.
Commissioner Frank Hodge gave the invocation.

Approval of the Agenda

Public Comments

Mayor Eagles presented a proclamation to the staff of Eastern Wake Dialysis, declaring the week of Feb. 9-13 as Dialysis Technician Week. Representatives from the clinic accepted the proclamation and thanked the Town Board for the recognition.

Mayor Eagles presented the Black Senior Citizen Award to Mrs. Dorothy Jones, thanking her for her life-long service to the Town of Rolesville and its residents.

Gejuan Batson, chair of the Rolesville Fireworks 500 Club reported on on-going fundraising efforts for the July 4th event. She also requested that the board allow the group to rent the community center at a reduced rate to host its upcoming Casino Night.

Mr. Hicks said he will speak with the Parks and Recreation Department and work with the committee on a rate and date.

Ms. Batson also requested changing the set parade route for the event so that it would end on Rogers Road near Granite Falls Boulevard. Mr. Hicks suggested the committee fill out a special events application so that the proposed route can be reviewed by the public safety committee.
