APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Mayor Eagles called the work session to order at 5:30 p.m. and read the following statement:

ROLESVILLE HIGH SCHOOL RECOGNITIONS

Commissioner Michelle Medley in tandem with Ms. Dhedra Lassiter, Principal of Rolesville High School recognized Coach Paul Thomas Moore upon his retirement from his position as Athletic Director at Rolesville High School. Coach Moore was presented with a plaque from the Town of Rolesville.

Also recognized were Rolesville High School Teacher of the Year Maurice Myers and 2018 Rolesville High School Beginning Teacher of the Year Rebekeh Townsend. Neither Teacher was present to receive their plaques from the Town of Rolesville

Elizabeth Hons was honored for winning the Oratorical State Title for the North Carolina Talk Off representing Wake Forest American Legion Post 187. Ms. Hons was presented with a certificate from the Town of Rolesville.

Student Allison Lenihan was honored for winning 1st place in the Raleigh Arts Festival. Ms. Lenihan was not present to accept her certificate from the Town of Rolesville.

Members present from the 2018 Rolesville High School NAC Conference Champion Track Team were honored and presented with a certificate.

ROSE & ASSOCIATES FINAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIC PLAN PRESENTATION

Kathleen Rose provided a presentation on the final Economic Development Strategic Plan designed by her company.

LAUNCH ROSEVILLE PRESENTATION BY ROLESVILLE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

The consensus from the board was to allow the Chamber the pick of best available Town space for the Launch Rolesville program.

VOTING ON TOWN OF ROLESVILLE FY18/19 BUDGET

Finance Officer Amy Stevens provided a brief overview of the budget under consideration during recent meetings.

Moved by Mayor Pro Tem Currin to adopt the Budget Ordinance for fiscal year July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, including the updated Capita Project Ordinance for Granite Falls Boulevard from Rogers Road to Grand Rock Way, and the Resolution authorizing the Wake County Department of Revenue to levy and collect property taxes for the Town of Rolesville; seconded by Commissioner Wilson. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Discussion was held on the following:

- Schedule of future staffing and equipment now that the budget has been adopted.
- Communicating Town Board meeting time changes with citizens. Consensus of the Town Board was to move the July meeting to July 17th at 7:00 p.m. Public to be informed.
- Funding and schedule of sidewalk from the Rolesville High School.
- Plan for building Granite Falls Boulevard. What is the timeframe? Keep stakeholders informed.
- How other municipalities do committees?
- JLL which is a company that is a part of the Greater Raleigh Convention Center and Visitors Bureau and is looking to help Rolesville become more of a destination.

At the behest of Mayor Eagles, Ms. April Chalk, 11008 Sandaway Lane was allowed to address the Board with her ongoing concern with a neighboring property owner who, as owner of a Tree Service, is cutting trees and stacking them on the property line adjacent to her property. Mayor Eagles expressed that new Town Manager Kelly Arnold would look into how best to mitigate her complaint.

Moved by Commissioner Wilson to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Commissioner Medley. Motion carried by unanimous vote. Meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
