Construction Drawings

Planning & Zoning-Planning Staff/WithersRavenel

1. Continue to Provide a Written Response to ALL comments.

Response: These have been provided under a separate letter.

2. REPEAT - Add Revision Dates to all submittal materials – Especially the Plan Set.

Response: Revision dates have been included.

3. <u>Legibility of this PDF is poor</u> - specifically on Grading and Drainage sheets – and Staff has to sometimes guess what some of the written text is; Staff cannot perform an complete review with it in this state; Please re-plot or convert this at a better resolution.

Response: The legibility has been corrected with this resubmittal.

4. Cover Sheet – revise title to "Construction Drawings for Kalas Falls Phase 3" & add "CD 21-07".

Response: This has been added to the coversheet.

5. <u>Cover Sheet</u> – put all Signature Blocks together at bottom of sheet. Leave blank space for TOR.

Response: All signature blocks excluding Wake County are located on the lower portion of the coversheet.

8. Reroute the Greenway behind lots 234 and 235 – Greenways do not run in front of homes.

Response: The greenway has been rerouted behind these lots and is now running adjacent to lot 235 to get to the intersection.

9. Widen the Greenway easement to 30' (current standard is 50', with reduction to 30' for environmental reasons). 20' is wholly insufficient space for maintenance/repair work to occur.

Response: The easement widths have been adjusted to 30'.

10. Confirm if physical Greenway trail will continue all of the way to northern property line or if it Proposed to stop before it reaches this point. If it stops short of the property line, please explain why.

Response: The trail will stop short of the property-line so that the grading can tie back to existing within the project limits.

11. Revise landscape plan to remove Ulmus parvifolia, which is considered by the State to be an invasive –

Response: Planting Plan has been updated to remove invasive species.

12. Revise landscape plans to provide more diversity of native trees and shrubs, which currently shows none.

Response: Planting plan has been updated to include a greater diversity of native trees and shrubs.
