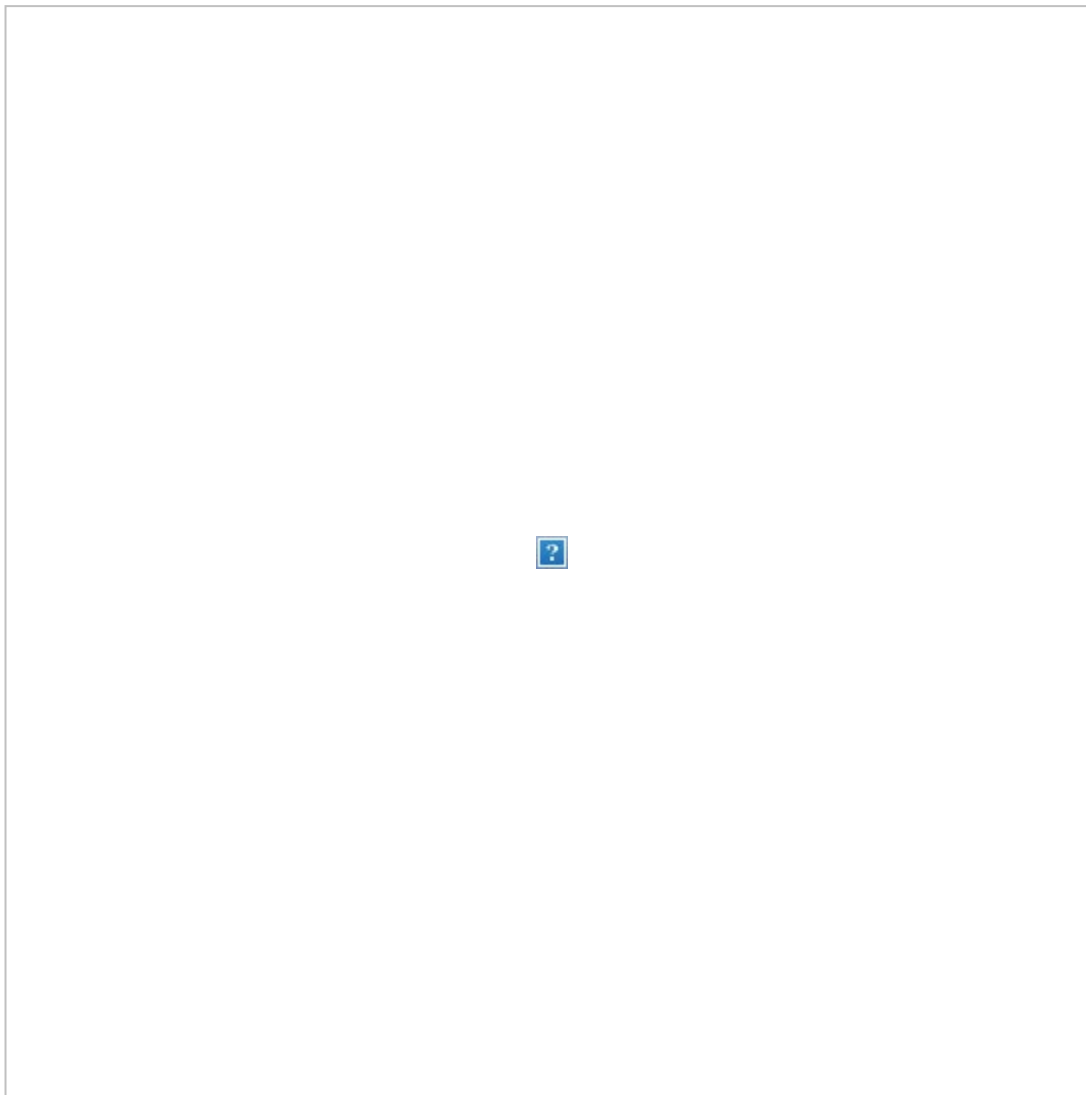

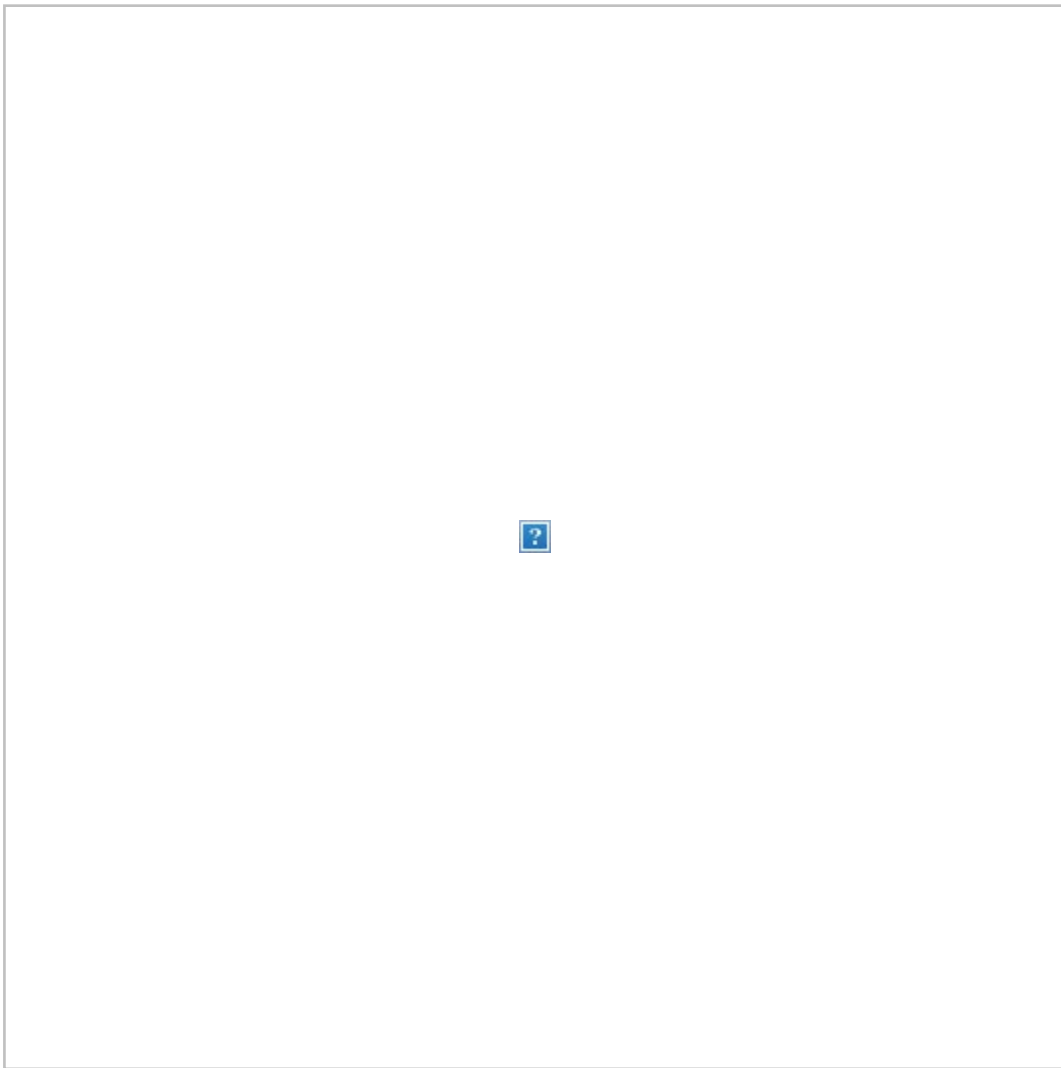

## **Golden Years Expo: National Senior Citizen Day Tribute**

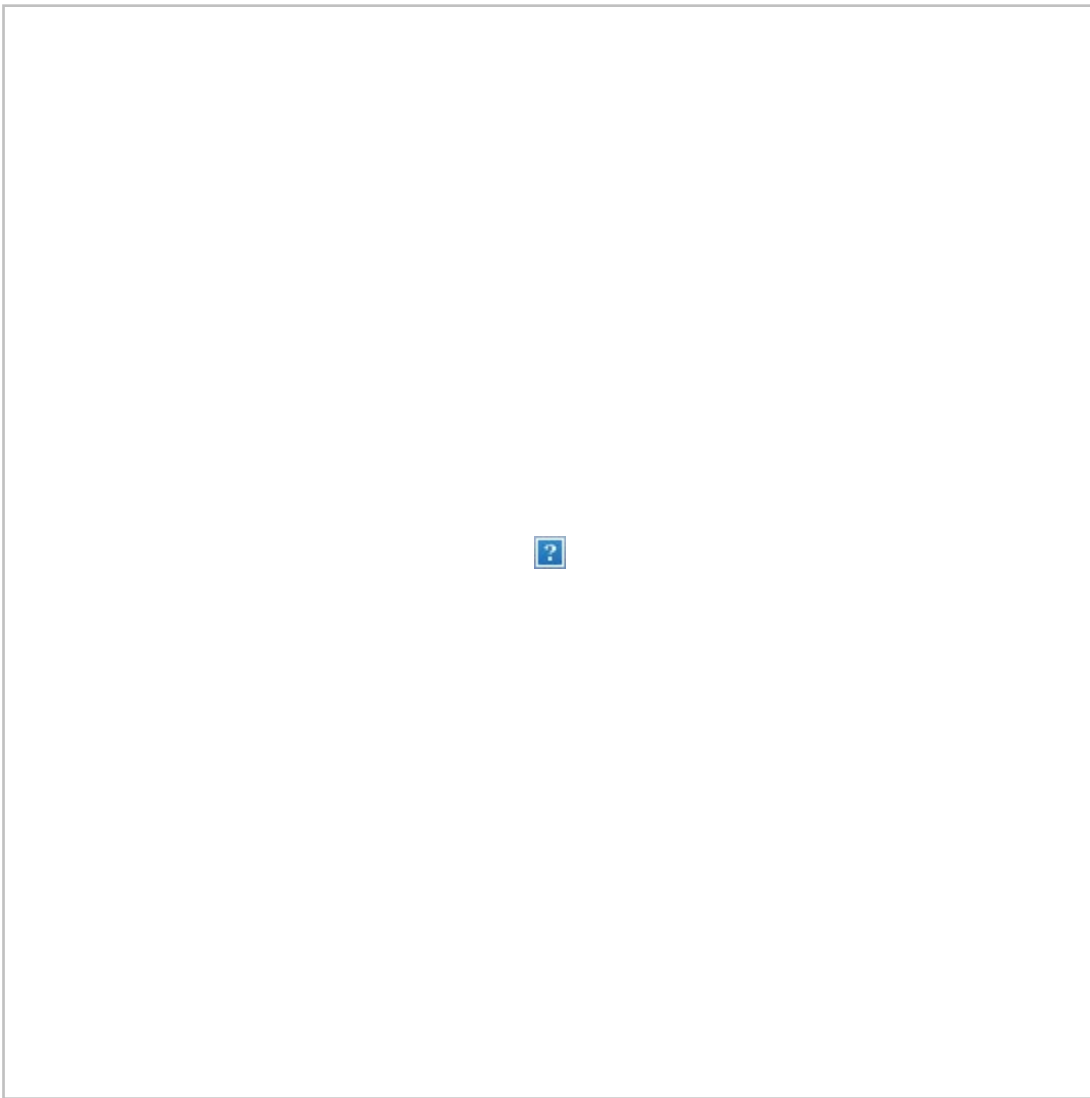

Construction on the Young and Main Street intersection is moving along. Last week, crews began digging out the road.

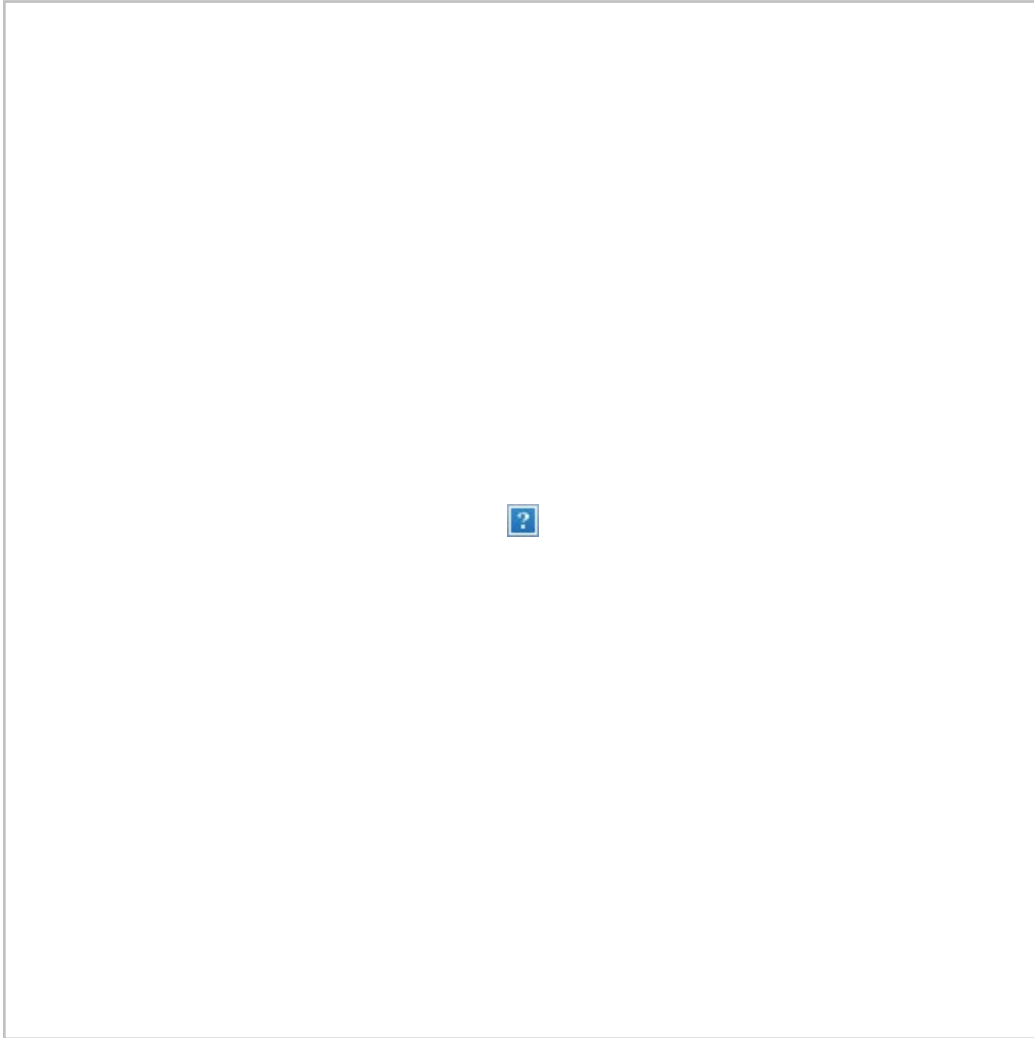

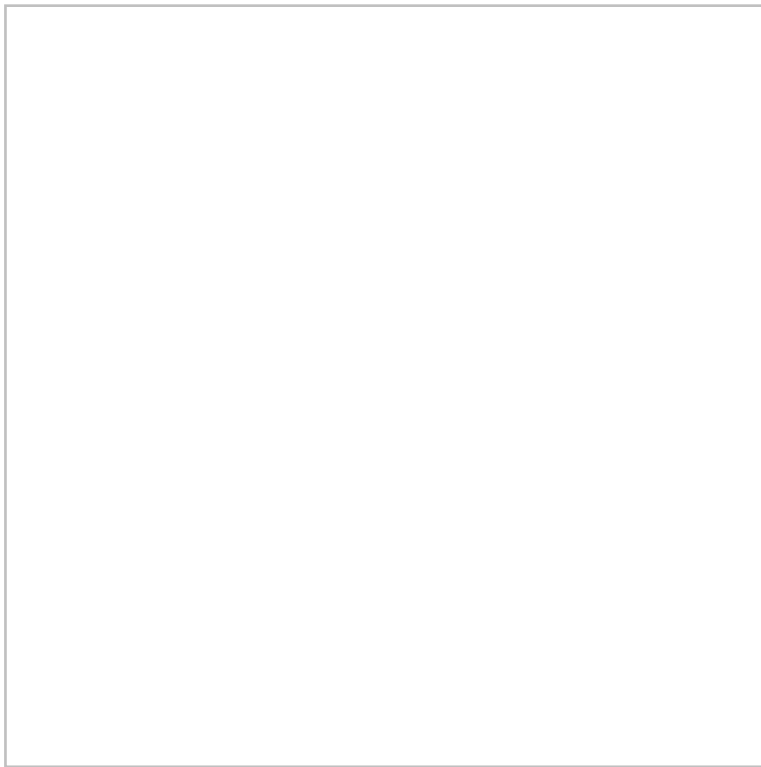
**New Residential Development - Rolesville Crossing**



Construction began on July 11, 2024 at the Rolesville Crossing residential subdivision. It is generally located on and between Rolesville Road and Mitchell Mill Road on land tracts addressed as 1801 Rolesville Road and 6301 Mitchell Mill Road. This project will consist of a maximum of 297 residential units (with Townhomes comprising a maximum of 120 of those total units).

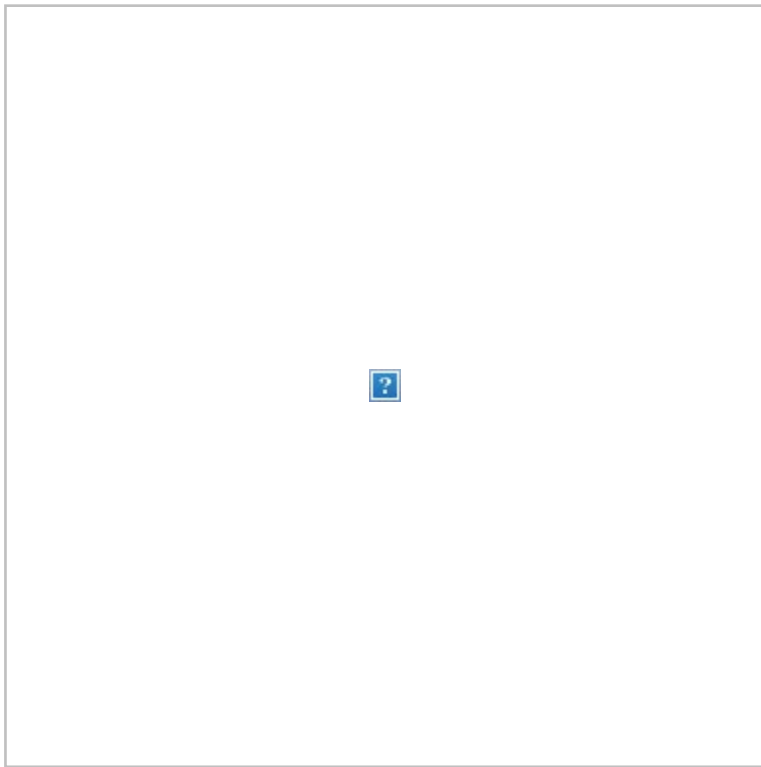

Tree City USA Community Tree Board

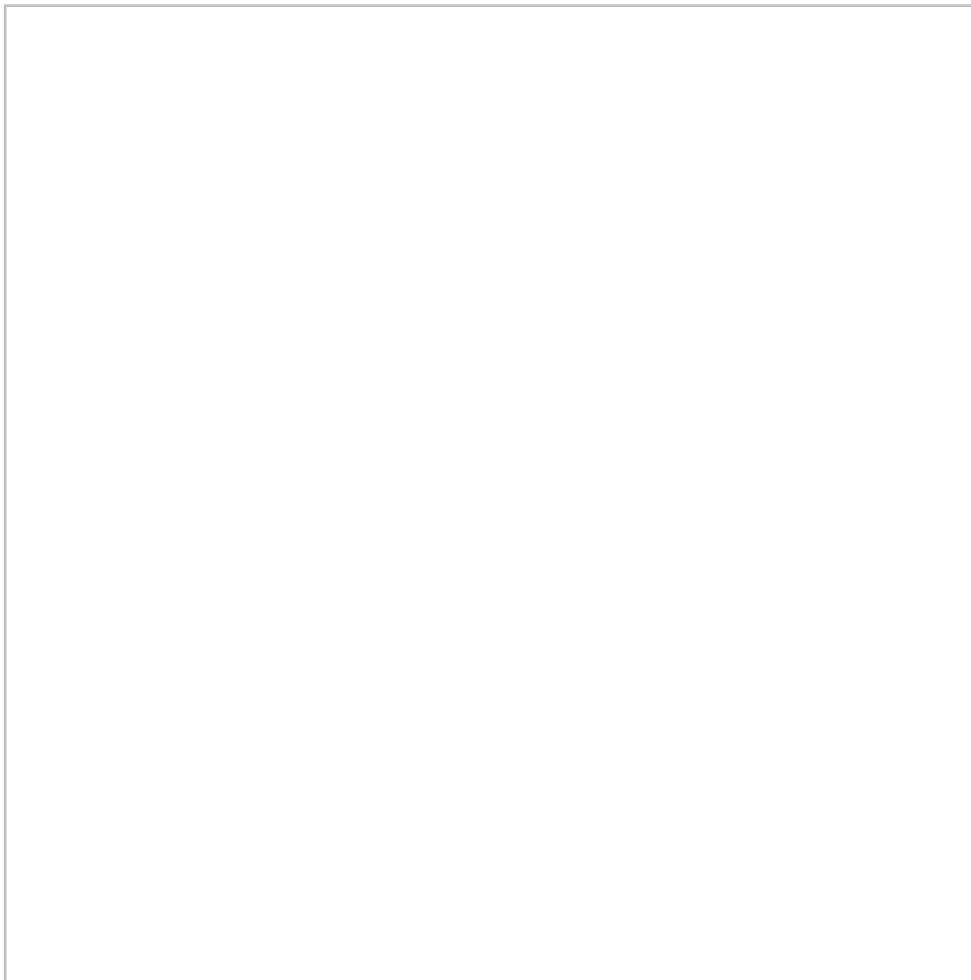

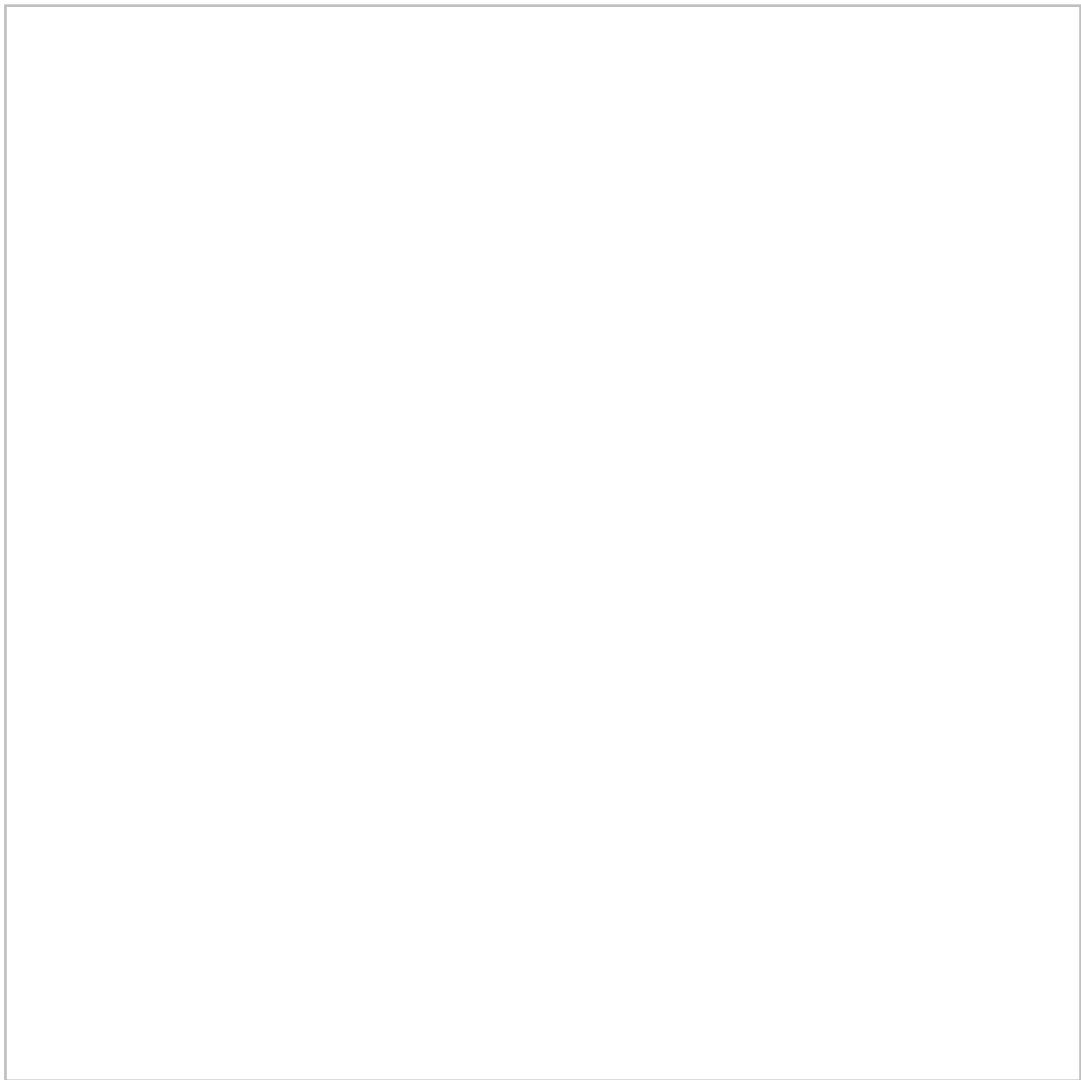

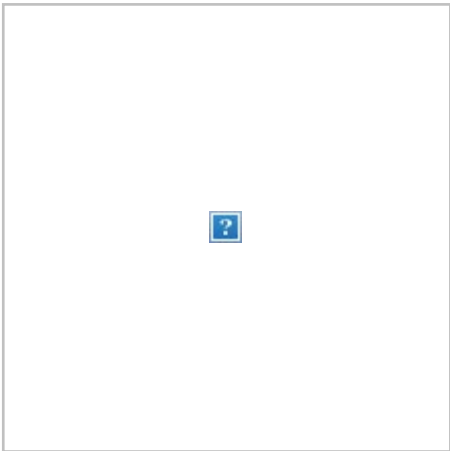
